<p>Count and Tally how many windows, doors and beds are in your house. Which do you have the most of? Which do you have the least of? Why could that be?</p>	<p>Read a couple books on your own out loud to a family member, pet, or stuffed animals!</p>	<p>Draw a picture of what it looks like outside and then try to add words to describe what it looks like.</p>	<p>Ask an adult what it was like when they were in Kindergarten. What games did they play? What did they do in school? How was it the same and how was it different than what it is like for you?</p>	<p>Art Draw a picture of what it looks like out your window or go out and make snow people if it's safe outside!</p>
<p>Use a timer (on a phone/the stove/a clock...) and see how long it takes you to: Do 10 jumping jacks. Do 10 push ups. Do 10 sit ups. (add you own) Did it take the same amount of time? Why?</p>	<p>Play I SPY words I can read around the house (on food packages/signs/anywhere) and write them down.</p>	<p>Practice writing our sight words (those must know words like: go/see/like...). You can write them with a pencil or how about in flour on a pan (get creative).</p>	<p>Find out what your address is and see if you can memorize it to tell to the teacher when you come back to school!</p>	<p>Music Sing one of our favorite Kindergarten songs to someone in your house. See if you can teach it to them! Can you be your own drummer and keep the beat as you sing? (Examples: You are My Sunshine/Skidamarink...etc.)</p>
<p>Play I SPY numbers around the house (on food packages/signs/anywhere) and write them down. Read the numbers back to an adult or sibling.</p>	<p>Listen to a story on www.storylineonline.net Draw a picture of the character(s) in that story.</p>	<p>Write a letter to your teacher telling them what you are doing on this E-learning day. Bring it to school and maybe they will write back to you! .</p>	<p>Create a map of your bedroom. Remember to label things in your room.</p>	<p>Media/Tech Literacy Record yourself reading a book or singing a song and see how it sounds! Can you do it a few times and make it better each time?</p>
